ii) farmers be given additional incentive at the rate of ₹ 500/quintal for Arhar (Tur), Urad and Moong sold to Government Procurement Agencies during the harvest/arrival period of two months. The procurement agency will procure pulses and disburse the subsidy to the farmers at the rate of ₹ 500/quintal and will not add on this subsidy to the sale cost of the

pulses. This additional incentive will be reimbursed to the procurement agency as and when they submit their claim to the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation.

- the prices for different varietal groups of rice be derived from the minimum support prices of paddy on the basis of hulling / milling ratios as well as the processing and incidental charges obtaining in different states;
 - (iv) the prices of varieties of cotton grown in different states, other than those in the groups of short, medium, Long and Extra Long Cotton (Kapas) be fixed keeping in view the normal market price differentials between Basic Staple Length of 24.5 mm to 25.5 mm and Micronaire value 4.3 – 5.1; Long Staple Length 29.5 mm – 30.5 mm and Micronaire value of 3.5 – 4.3 and other varieties and technical parameters;
 - (v) In the case of cereals, FCI and other designated State Agencies may continue to provide price support to the farmers, as in the past. NAFED would continue to be the nodal agency for procurement of oilseeds and pulses. Reimbursement of National Agricultural Marketing Federation's (NAFED) losses on account of these operations would continue to be capped at 15%. NAFED would also continue to undertake procurement of cotton, in addition to Cotton Corporation of India (CCI).
