Sub: District-wise allotment of food grains (Rice & Wheat) for PHH and AAY families under NFSA for the month of January, 2018.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise allocation of **15,45,114.97 quintals** of rice and **2,44,176.82 quintals** of wheat from Central Pool for distribution among the Priority Households (PHH) and Antodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households under NFSA-2013 for the month of **January 2018** as per enclosed Annexure-I.

The above revised food grain allocations is based on the food grain combination of rice & wheat as opted by all PHH beneficiaries in 30 districts (out of the 5 Kgs entitlement per person per month). In case of AAY beneficiaries, the entire entitlement of 35 Kgs is rice only per household per month.

The closing balance quantity of rice & wheat for the allotment month of November 2017 has been calculated in the following manner & deducted from the allotment quantity of January 2018:

1. The physical balance of rice & wheat at FPSs for November 2017, as reported by the MIs in the FPS portal, has been adjusted towards the allotment of January 2018.
2. For the FPSs whose physical balance has not been reported by the MIs in FPS portal, 30% of the entitlement for the said FPSs, has been taken as closing balance and adjusted towards the allotment of January 2018. The MIs should be directed to update the physical balance of such FPSs in FPS portal by 10th December 2017 after which the required shortfall quantities if any shall be released to those FPSs on 11th December 2017 through the final State Allotment Order.
3. It has been observed that in case of some FPSs, MIs have reported physical balance more than 30% of the entitlement of the FPSs. For such FPSs, 30% out of the entitlement has been taken as closing balance and adjusted towards the allotment of January 2018. If it is not correct physical balance, the MIs should be directed to update the actual one in FPS portal by 10th December 2017 after which the required shortfall quantities if any shall be released to those FPSs on 11th December 2017 through the final State Allotment Order.

Distribution of stocks at FPS points should be made only through e-Pos devices. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the stock/sales records must be kept for future reference/verification & the physical balance should be entered by Marketing Inspectors in the FPS portal for the concerned Fair Price Shop (FPS) at the end of the distribution.

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THE DISTRICTS SHOULD ENSURE AT LEAST 75% BIO-METRIC AADHAAR AUTHENTICATED TRANSACTIONS THROUGH E-POS WITH REFERENCE TO THE DISTRICT AADHAAR SEEDING PERCENTAGE.

Online Allotment Orders are being generated District wise for both PHH & AAY beneficiaries as per details in the newly issued ration cards. The District Civil Supplies Officer is to generate/download Fair Price Shop wise allotment order from the system in CSO login of OTPDS URL www.pdsodisha.gov.in (link given in MIS Report section) for each Block and ULB and communicate it to the concerned BDOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs with copy to EO of ULBs for further action at their level. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the Allotment Order in their respective RCMS login in above OTPDS URL. The FPS-wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above allocations and made available in the link <http://164.100.141.68/TPDSTest/TPDS/Reports/SalesRegisterReport.aspx> for the Blocks and ULBs to download and use during manual transaction if any. **The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices of those Fair Price Shops which have received the devices to carry out PoS based distribution of food grain entitlement of beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device after 1st date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.**

As per the provision of NFSA-2013 and as per decision of Government of Odisha, the PHH are entitled to get **5 (Five) Kilograms** of food grain (rice, wheat or combination of both) per person per month @ Re.1/- per Kg. The AAY beneficiaries will continue to get **35 Kgs** of rice per household per month @ Re. 1/- per Kg. The food grains (rice or wheat or both) shall be distributed to the PHH & AAY households against new ration cards issued under NFSA-2013 at the above prescribed rates.

- I. The per card entitlement of food grains (rice, wheat or combination of both) @ 5 kg per person per month @ Re 1/- per kg shall be distributed to the priority house hold (PHH) under NFSA 2013.
- II. Per Card entitlement of food grains will not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- III. The distribution of food grains may be undertaken as per the dateline mentioned in the table below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- IV. If any entitled/eligible ration card holder fails to receive his/her quota of PDS commodities on the fixed days of distribution, he/she may be allowed to receive the same till the end of the month.
- V. All the PDS distribution should be completed as per the dateline mentioned in table below. Undistributed allotment of food grains will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for for next allotment month.
- VI. Certificate of GPLAC or WLAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO/Sub Collector/ADM under counter signature of Inspector of Supplies/ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guidelines.
- VII. **Out of the total allotment in favour of Gajapati district, the allotment for Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district, for September & October 2017 is diverted to Rayagada district for distribution among the PHH & AAY beneficiaries of the above GP. The CSO, Rayagada is requested to ensure lifting of the above quantities of rice and wheat from Gudari Block for smooth distribution among the genuine beneficiaries of Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district.
