**Sub: State Pool allotment of BPL rice for ST & SC Hostels  
for the months from October 2010 to March, 2011.**

Sir,

I am directed to communicate district wise allotment of 3782.37 MT of BPL rice for ST and SC Hostels for each month of October 2010 to March 2011 from the State pool as per the quantity mentioned against each in the Annexure enclosed. The scale of entitlement will be limited to @ 15 Kg. per inmate per month @ Rs.2/- per Kg. uniformly. The entire quantity of this allotment will be provided by the OSCSC Ltd. from the State pool.

2. The validity period for depositing cost and lifting of allotted food grains for the months of October, November, December 2010 and January 2011 will be 45 days from the date of issue of Govt. of India letter, which was issued on 22.12.2010. The deposit of cost and lifting of food grains for subsequent months of February, March 2011 will be as per the normal procedure under TPDS allocation.

3. All other terms conditions are remain unaltered this allocation may be distributed only amongst ST & SC Hostels as per the list provided by the ST & SC Dev. Deptt. on the basis of intake capacity and the number of inmates approved by ST & SC Dev. Deptt.


4. There will be no diversion of rice from other schemes henceforth with.

5. Institutions should be given entitlement cards to enable them to draw rice. The officers of concerned Department will certify utilization of stock for bonafide purpose in the card every month.

6. The institutions will lift their quota from the concerned Storage Agent and they will not be asked to lift rice from F.C.I. / D.P.C. depots. S.A. will issue cash memo to the institutions and obtain signature.

7. In case, closing stock is available with the institutions, equal quantity will be reduced from the allocation for the next month. However, full quota of central Pool and State Pool must be lifted by OSCSC Ltd. / SA and no quantity should be allowed to lapse.


