Materials to be floated in Government website

- In response to the Government in FS & CW Department notification No. 24296 dt.12.11.2009, applications were invited from eligible candidates for recruitment to the post of Inspector of Supplies & M.I.Inspector for filling up of the following number of posts.
 - a. Inspectors of Supplies-
- (i) 49 regular posts
- (ii) 70 temporary posts under 'Rs. 2/per kg rice scheme'
- b. M.I.Inspectors-
- 44 temporary posts under 'Rs. 2/per kg rice scheme'
- 2. Accordingly, 51821 number of applications received from the candidates having minimum qualification i.e., Bachelor degree or an equivalent examination. It was seen that out of 51821, number of applications received so far; 20 applications do not contain any OMR application form for which those applications were not taken into consideration.
- 3. Remaining 51801 number of applications were scrutinised and scanned and scanned date were finally checked manually. It was revealed after scanning that 5252 number of applications were rejected due to overage/underage of the applicants and finally 46549 number of applications were taken into consideration.
- During scanning, the information given by the candidates in the OMR application forms in shape of bubbles is taken into consideration and report generated accordingly.
- 5. Selection of candidates was made on the basis of the marks secured by them in Secondary, Higher Secondary and Graduation examination conducted by Board, council and University as the case may be. Weightage was assigned on the marks secured by the candidate in the following manner:
 - i. Secondary examination= 30%
 - ii. Higher Secondary Examination=30%
 - iii. Graduation Examination=40%

Provisional list of 163 candidates for appointment to the post of post Inspector of Supplies & M.I. Inspectors has been drawn up on the basis of weightage, percentage of marks obtained in three examinations.

Any omission or commission noticed in the list of successful candidates or otherwise may be brought to the notice of Deputy Director-cum-Under Secretary, FS & CW Department, Bhubaneswar in the form of affidavit duly sworn in by the candidates before Executive Magistrate.
