Sub: District-wise bi-monthly State Allotment Order of food grains (Rice & Wheat) for PHH and AAY families under NFSA for the month of **July & August 2020**.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise final bi-monthly allocation of **32,64,068.02 quintals of rice and 4,82,263.28 quintals of wheat** from Central Pool for distribution among the Priority Households (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households under NFSA-2013 for the month of **July & August 2020** as per enclosed Annexure-I.

As per the provision of NFSA-2013 and as per decision of Government of Odisha, the PHH beneficiaries are entitled to get **5 (Five) Kilograms** of food grain (rice, wheat or combination of both) per person per month @ **Re.1/- per Kg**. The AAY beneficiaries will continue to get **35 Kgs** of rice per household per month @ **Re. 1/- per Kg**. The food grains (rice or wheat or both) shall be distributed to the PHH & AAY households against new ration cards issued under NFSA-2013 at the above prescribed rates.

1. The allotted PDS stocks should be released only to those Fair Price Shops which have valid FPS license/renewal for the Financial Year 2020-21 (till March 2021).
2. Lifting & distribution of allotted PDS commodities should be carried out as per the timeline in the table on Page-3.
3. **Distribution of stocks at FPS points should be made only through e-PoS devices, by Aadhaar bio-metric authentication method, using finger print scanner/IRIS fitted to the e-PoS device. ACSOs/MIs should ensure more than 75% Aadhaar authenticated distribution at Fair Price Shops.** However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, offline/manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval from concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the transaction records must be processed through e-PoS and data shall be synced to the FPS server subsequently. In order to achieve Aadhaar bio-metric authentication under COVID-19 pandemic situation and as per advisories issued by the State Government from time to time, it shall be ensured that required quantities of sanitizers and other necessary logistic are made available in all FPSs for sanitizing the finger print scanner/IRIS fitted to the e-PoS before scanning of bio-metric of each beneficiary by maintaining social distance.
4. Portability shall continue in all Fair Price Shops of Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC) in Khordha district from July-August 2020 distribution month onwards.

5. Post allotment card tagging/rationalization should be given effect to in RCMS immediately so that it gets reflected in next months' allotment/ revised allotment (if any). In case of one to one merging of FPS allotments (total quantities of one FPS to be merged with another FPS), mail to be sent from official CSO mail ID to domains.pmutpds@gmail.com for giving effect in RCMS & SCMS for smooth lifting. In case of distribution, the e-PoS device should be retrieved from the outgoing FPS Dealer and distribution should be made after downloading the allotment through the same device, without changing the configuration. Once distribution is completed and data uploaded to FPS server, the device should be re-configured with any new FPS code.
6. All eligible Aadhaar by-passed cases (special cases) certified by MIs in fps portal till the last distribution month (s), have been incorporated in the RCMS database and accordingly allotment have been generated for distribution. The MIs need to certify in fps portal only fresh special cases for getting it displayed in e-PoS for distribution out of the available stock in the FPS. However, in order to replenish the stocks (if required), the MI need to submit a requisition to the CSO-cum-District Manager in the following format to get it released from the concerned RRC-cum-DSC:

7. After receipt of requisition from the MI, CSO-cum-District Manager shall issue instructions to the concerned RRC-cum-DSC by forwarding the requisition, to release the stocks to the concerned FPSs. This shall be treated by the RRC-cum-DSC as part of State Allocation Order and stocks shall be released to the FPSs accordingly.
8. In no case, RRC-cum-DSC shall issue stocks of rice or wheat or any other PDS commodities **over & above the Allocation Orders communicated by the FS&CW Department/OSCSC Ltd/CSO-cum-District Manager.**
9. **Implementation online Stock Receipt feature in e-PoS:** In order to stop erroneous entries made in e-PoS during receipt of PDS stocks from RRC-cum-DSCs, online integration of SCMS despatches (through FPS Acceptance Note) with FPS server has been done. FPSAN generated in RRC-cum-DSCs are now being pulled into FPS server at a frequency of every 30 minutes. The pulled FPSANs are made available in e-PoS devices in near real-time mode. On clicking 'Stock Receive' tab in e-PoS, Dealer will see all available FPS Acceptance Notes despatched from RRC-cum-DSC to choose the specific FPSAN and then select item to receive. This will eliminate the need for dealer to enter the FPSAN number manually thereby avoiding any errors during entry of FPSAN quantity. However, in extreme case, if FPSAN is not available (because of poor network connectivity of device), option to manually enter FPSAN is still available.
10. **Return of empty gunny bags by FPS Dealers:** All Civil Supplies Officers shall ensure that all empty gunny bags at Fair Price Shop points are returned by the FPS Dealers as per the modalities issued by OSCSC Ltd earlier.

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The CSO-cum-District Manager shall download the Block/ULB wise allotment of PDS commodities made available online inside CSO login of www.pdsodisha.gov.in and communicate it to concerned In Charge of RRC-cum-DSCs for release of stocks to FPSs for distribution, along with the State Allotment Order letter issued from the Department, with copy marked to BDOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs and EO of ULBs for information. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the FPS-wise State Allotment quantities made available in their respective RCMS login of www.pdsodisha.gov.in for record.

The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices to carry out distribution of food grain entitlement to beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device on or after 1st date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.

Other instructions:

- I. Per Card entitlement of food grains will not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- II. The distribution of food grains may be undertaken as per the dateline mentioned in the table below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- III. Undistributed allotment of food grains will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for next allotment month (s).
- IV. Certificate of GPLAC or WLAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO/Sub Collector/ADM under counter signature of Inspector of Supplies/ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guidelines.
- V. **Out of the total allotment in favour of Gajapati district, the allotment for Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district is diverted to Rayagada district for distribution among the PHH & AAY beneficiaries of the above GP. The CSO, Rayagada is requested to ensure lifting of the above quantities of rice and wheat from Gudari Block for smooth distribution among the genuine beneficiaries of Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district. (Details of Garadama GP allotment & number of beneficiaries can be downloaded from RCMS CSO login under "Allotment under NFSA" link).**
