**Sub:** District-wise **bi-monthly** State Allotment Order of Rice & Chana Whole for distribution among migrant workers under 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat' in view of COVID-19 for the month of **May & June 2020**.

**Ref:** This Department letter No 8606 Dated 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district-wise bi-monthly allocation of **15,077.00 quintals rice** and **3,015.40 quintals chana whole** from Central Pool for distribution among migrant workers under 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat' in view of COVID-19, for the month of **May & June 2020** as per enclosed Annexure-I.

The entitlement of rice is **5kgs per person per month** and **chana whole is 1kg per family per month, free of cost.**

1. The Block/ULB wise distribution list has been uploaded in RCMS login for download and use during distribution of entitlement. Both rice and chana whole entitlements have been allocated individually. Since chana whole entitlement is family based, it is to ensure determination of a family unit while distributing the same and issue 1kg chana whole to a family per month.
2. The district & Block/ULB wise State Allocations have been captured centrally in SCMS software application for lifting from RRC-cum-DSCs. The list of migrant workers uploaded inside RCMS login should be cross-verified with NFSA and SFSS databases before issue of entitlements. It is requested to ensure immediate lifting and distribution of above entitlements to migrant workers those who are not covered under NFSA or SFSS.
3. While lifting rice and chana whole, the quantity already lifted and distributed should be deducted from the total allocations as indicated in the table annexed.
4. **The entire allotted stocks should be lifted by 20<sup>th</sup> June 2020 without fail.**
