I am directed to state that the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare, Government of India vide letter No.6-2/2020-FES-ES dated 25.9.2020 (copy enclosed) has fixed the Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) of Rabi Crops for Marketing Season 2021-22 as under:-

Rapeseed & Mustard	4650
Safflower	5327

It is requested that wide publicity may be given to the above MSPs fixed by the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare, Government of India for procurement in RMS 2021-22, so that farmers are well informed about MSP announced in the States concerned and their participation in MSP programme is ensured.



**Subject: Price Policy for Rabi Crops for Marketing Season 2021-22-- Fixation of Minimum Support Prices.**

Government of India has fixed the Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) for mandated Rabi Crops (Fair Average Quality) for Marketing Season 2021-22 as under:

Commodity (Fair Average Quality)	(Rs. per quintal) Minimum Support Price
Wheat	1975
Barley	1600
Gram	5100
Masur (Lentil)	5100
Rapeseed & Mustard	4650
Safflower	5327

- 1.2 The prices of other oilseeds belonging to the rapeseed and mustard group such as toria be fixed on the basis of their normal market price differentials with rapeseed & mustard.
- 1.3 In the case of cereals and coarse cereals, Food Corporation of India (FCI) and other designated state agencies would continue to provide price support to the farmers. State Governments will undertake procurement of coarse grains with prior approval of Government and would distribute the entire procured quantity under National Food Security Act (NFSA). The subsidy will be provided only for the quantity issued under NFSA. National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED), Small Farmers Agri - Business Consortium (SFAC) and other designated central agencies would continue to undertake procurement of pulses and oilseeds. The losses, if any, incurred by the nodal agencies in such operations may be fully reimbursed by the Government as per the guidelines.
2. The Ministries/Departments concerned are requested to take necessary action for providing price support operations as well as for wide dissemination of related information.
