Subject: Price policy for Kharif Crops for Marketing Season 2023-24-- Fixation of Minimum Support Prices.

Government of India has fixed the Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) for all mandated Kharif Crops (Fair Average Quality) for Marketing Season 2023-24. MSP of mandated Kharif crops for marketing season 2023-24 is as under:

1.2 The prices for different variety groups of rice be derived from the MSPs of paddy on the basis of hulling/milling ratios as well as the processing and incidental charges obtaining in different states.

1.3. The prices of other varieties of cotton will be fixed by the Ministry of Textiles keeping in view the normal market price differentials and differentials between their staple lengths, micronaire value and other technical parameters.

1.4 In case of cereals and coarse cereals, Food Corporation of India (FCI) and other designated State Agencies would continue to provide price support to the farmers. State Governments will undertake procurement of coarse grains with the prior approval of Government and would distribute the entire procured quantity under National Food Security Act (NFSA). The subsidy will be provided only for the quantity issued under NFSA. National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED), Small Farmers Agri – Business Consortium (SFAC) and other designated Central Agencies would continue to undertake procurement of pulses and oilseeds. Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) will be the central nodal agency for undertaking price support operations for cotton. The losses, if any, incurred by the nodal agencies in such operations may be fully reimbursed by the Government as per the guidelines.

2. The Ministries/Departments concerned are requested to take necessary action for providing price support operations as well as for wide dissemination of related information.
